Notice of preliminary determination for rights of priority – prawn nets (set pocket)

I, Rick Morton, Acting District Fisheries Officer Clarence, pursuant to clause 35H of the Fisheries Management (Estuary General Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006 (the EG Plan), determine that for the period 1 August 2021 to 31 May 2022:

1. The maximum number of prawn nets (set pocket) that may be used in the waters of the Clarence River will be 133.
2. The net sites will be the sites and general locations specified in Schedule 1,
3. The setting times for prawn nets (set pocket) in the Clarence River will be:
 - a. from the turn of the tide or sunset, whichever occurs first, and
 - b. to sunrise.

Pursuant to clause 35I of the EG Plan and the Prawn Net (Set Pocket) Determination Guidelines 2018, I give notice that:

 - a. at 10am on the date specified in Schedule 2 to this notice, being the day of the full moon or preceding working day if the full moon falls on a weekend or public holiday, and
 - b. at the Clarence River Fishermen's Cooperative, 51-55 River Street, Maclean NSW 2463.

5. each endorsement holder must be in attendance and present their commercial fishing licence and fishing business cards (or digital authorities) to the nominated person.

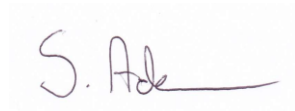

2. the net sites will be shots numbered 1-3 in consecutive order from line drawn at the boat ramp on Marine Parade north to the southernmost corner of the carpark adjacent to the Karagi Point reserve, downstream to the confluence of the Tasman Sea,
3. the setting times for prawn nets (set pocket) in Tuggerah Lake will be:
 - a. from immediately before 5pm Australian Eastern Standard Time, or 6pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (daylight saving time) when in force,
 - b. to sunrise.

Pursuant to clause 35I of the EG Plan and the Prawn Net (Set Pocket) Determination Guidelines 2018, I give notice that:

1. The nominated person to conduct the draw will be Neville Patterson or person nominated by Neville Patterson,
2. The draw will be conducted in accordance with the Prawn Net (Set Pocket) Determination Guidelines 2018,
3. The determination draw will take place:
 - a. at 11am on the date specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, being the day of the full moon or preceding working day if the full moon falls on a weekend or public holiday, and
 - b. at Tacoma Fisherman's Co-Operative, 77 Wolseley Ave, Tacoma NSW 2259
4. Each fishing period is the period from full moon to the next full moon.
5. Each endorsement holder must be in attendance and present their commercial fishing licence and fishing business cards (or digital authorities) to the nominated person.

For the purposes of this preliminary determination, ***sunrise*** on a day will occur at the time published by the Bureau of Meteorology at www.bom.gov.au.

Notice of preliminary determination for rights of priority - prawn running nets

I, Paul Frank, District Fisheries Officer Montague, pursuant to clause 35H of the *Fisheries Management (Estuary General Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006* (the EG Plan), determine that for the period 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022:

1. The net sites are those sites for which priority is held following the conduct of the prawn running net priority determination for this determination period, and
2. The net sites may be located adjacent to the waters of Coila Lake, Lake Brou, Corunna Lake, Tilba Tilba Lake, Cuttagee Lake, Middle Lake (Bega), Wallaga Lake. The attached maps show the available net sites in each lake. Net sites may be taken outside of those listed. Any location may be chosen in Lakes with no listed sites, provided it may lawfully be fished with a prawn running net.
3. The draw will be conducted in accordance with the Prawn Running Net Determination Guidelines 2018 and the attached "Additional Instructions".
4. The fishing period is the period from 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022.
5. Each endorsement holder must be available on their mobile phones and submit a text message as per the attached "Additional instructions".

Pursuant to clause 35I of the EG Plan and the Prawn Running Net Determination Guidelines 2018 and current Covid-19 advice, I give notice that:

1. The nominated person to conduct the draw will be an Officer of Fisheries NSW,
2. This year due to Covid-19 the determination draw will take place:
 - a. **Between 10am and 4pm on Friday 1 October 2021.**
 - b. **At the Montague Fisheries Office, Riverside Drive Narooma NSW 2546.**
 - c. Endorsement holders are not required to attend in person but **must be available on their mobile phones**
 - d. the determination will be conducted in accordance with the "Additional instructions".

This will be the final prawn determination conducted by Officers of NSW Fisheries. Future prawn determinations from the 2022/23 season onwards will be conducted by industry.

2021 Priority determination “Additional Instructions”
(COVID 19)

Dear Endorsement Holder,

As you are aware, it is the time of year when the priority determination for prawn running nets in Region 7 is normally conducted at the Montague Fisheries Office.

However due to Public health orders, travel restrictions and the risks involved in having large numbers of people gathered together in one location, it is clear that an alternate approach is required.

After consulting with Industry, it has been decided that the Region 7 prawn running net priority determination ballot will be undertaken by mobile phone (text messages) for the 21/22 fishing period.

Text messages will ensure that the process is transparent and that there is a record of each nomination for audit purposes. You may submit all ballots on a single text message. For those that are not aware, **the ballot system gives priority to endorsement holders with higher number of shares**. Every 100 shares above the minimum shareholding allows an additional ballot. I have also attached the ballot report.

Fishers are to refer to the enclosed maps and the instructions below. The maps for most eligible estuaries have pre-determined net sites listed on them. These have been derived from historical net site data.

You may choose a location not recorded on the maps, as long as this site is not within 75m of a mapped site. Furthermore, any site may be chosen in Lakes with no listed sites, provided that site may lawfully be fished with a prawn running net.

Given that we are working from maps and that the lake levels fluctuate please use common sense when taking up your priority net site/s.

Detailed instructions are found on the following page.

Instructions

With reference to the locations on the attached maps, endorsement holders must submit a text message between **10am and 11am on October 1, 2021** indicating their FB number and nominated net sites. The number of nominated net sites cannot exceed the number of ballots allocated to the FB.

If fishers wish to choose a net site not recorded on the maps, they will need to send the full GPS location. This site cannot be within 75m of a mapped site.

The phone number to send the text to is **0409 316 508**. 1 text message per endorsement holder. Please see below examples of the correct text format.

Example 1, a fisher who operates FB 111 with 1 ballot who wishes to place their ballot on site location “8” in Coila Lake would text: **FB 111, Coila Lake Site 8**.

Example 2: a fisher operating FB 222 who has 3 ballots wishes place a ballot on site 6 in Coila and a ballot on site 3 in Brou would text: **FB 222 Coila Lake Site 6, Brou Lake Site 3**. In this case the fisher also has a spare ballot that may be used later if multiple fishers compete for one of these sites.

Example 3: a fisher operating FB 333 who has 1 ballot wishes to place the ballot on a particular site in Corunna Lake that is not mapped would text: **FB 333, Corunna Lake, 36.281487, 150.110783**.

In the event that more than 1 fisher nominates the same net site, a Fisheries Officer will contact each fisher and proceed as per the relevant guidelines (attached) with text message confirmation. Fishers with additional ballots, may at this stage choose to allocate any additional ballots to the site or a fisher may change their nominated site. The fisher with the highest number of ballots gets priority at the site.

If none of the fishers involved wish to change their choice or additional ballots do not determine priority at the site, a coin toss is required. This will be done by a Fisheries Officer via video call (facetime or similar) with the respective fishers. The fisher/s that do not get priority at this site after the coin toss must then **choose a vacant net site** for the next determination round.

Please ensure that you are available and have mobile service on this day and have copies of the maps with you. If we cannot contact you, you may not get to choose an alternate location.

Furthermore, please ensure that you have **back up net sites** in case you do not get your first or second preference.

Once all shots are received and priority determined, each endorsement holder will receive a text message to this effect. The priority determination will be posted on the Departments website and at the respective Fisheries Offices and Fishing Co-operatives.

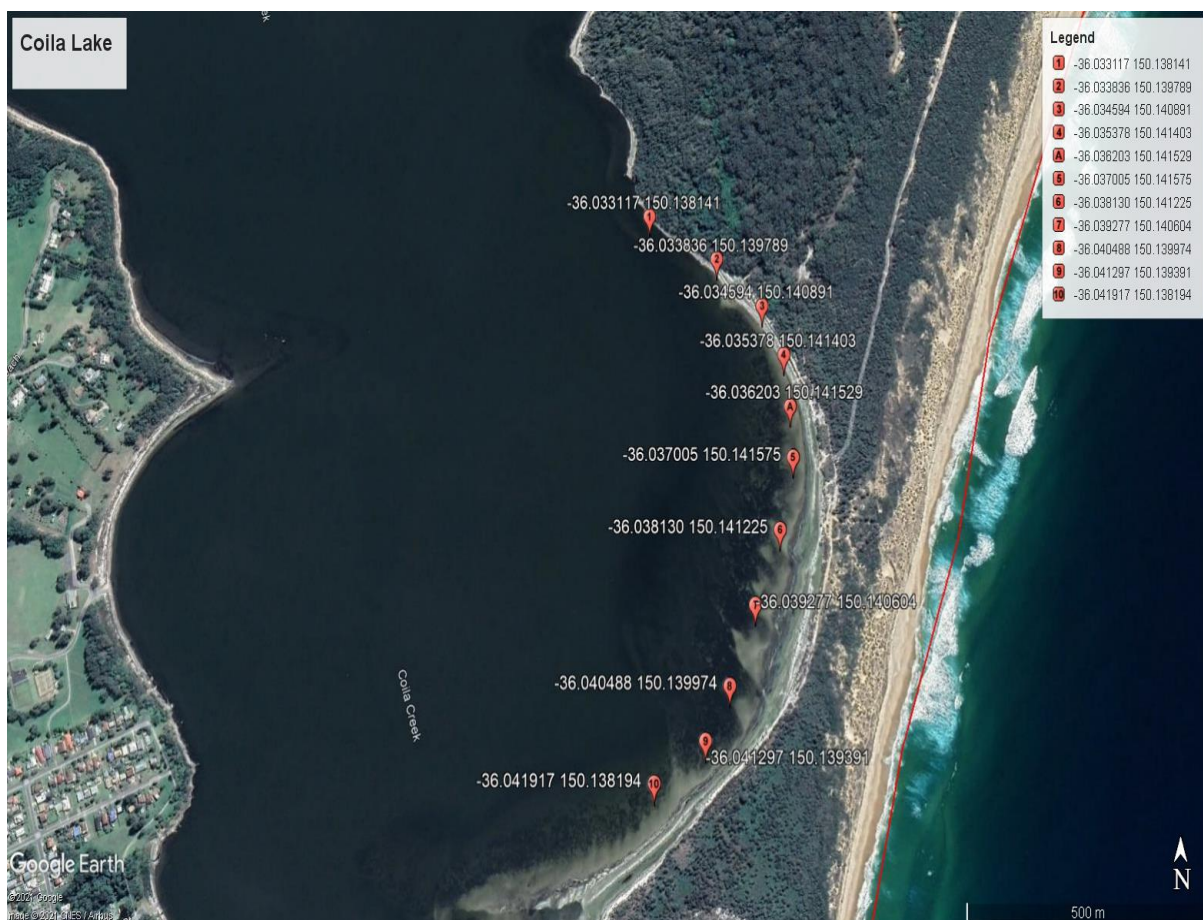
