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There can be only one nominated fisher for a fishing business at any given time. A person can be nominated to hold the same endorsement for two or more businesses if authorised to do so under the management plan for the fishery. A nomination does not take effect until the Department Primary Industries and Regional Development Fisheries (DPIRD Fisheries) approves this nomination form and the nominated fisher is in possession of the fishing business card or digital authority. Fishing business owners are responsible for ensuring that DPIRD Fisheries has approved a nomination form before the nominated fisher commences work. Once a nomination is made it must retain in effect for a **minimum of 12 hours**. Nominating a new fisher automatically revokes a previous nomination.

Privacy notice:

The personal information provided by you on this form is subject to the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1989. You must provide this information, otherwise the Department Primary Industries and Regional Development Fisheries (DPIRD Fisheries) cannot assess your application for a commercial fishing licence.
