Total Allowable Catch Determination - NSW Estuary General Hand Gathering Fishery

Estuary General Hand Gathering Fishery – 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022

The Total Allowable Fishing (TAF) Committee has made the following Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determinations for the NSW Estuary General Hand Gathering Fishery for the fishing period of 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022.

For the 2021/22 fishing period, the TAC for:

- Pipi and Cockles has increased; and
- Ghost nipper and Beachworms has remained the same.

The Department of Primary Industries will allocate quota to shareholders for the corresponding Estuary General Hand Gathering species prior to 1 July 2020.

Quota species	TAC determination (kg)	Fishing Period
Pipi	156,000	1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022
Cockles	45,000	1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022
Beachworms	8,500	1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022
Ghost Nipper	5,600	1 July 2021 - 30 June 2022

When the TAF Committee makes a TAC determination, the Committee provides a Determination Report that explains the reasons for their determination.
