

Required information for boats used for Ocean Trawl Prawning (effort quota)

Fisheries Management Act 1994: Cl.10 Fisheries Management (Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006

This application form is to be used by the owner of a fishing business to provide required information in respect of the boat to be used for ocean trawl prawning. It is an offence for the owner of a prawning fishing business to use a boat or permit a boat to be used for ocean trawl prawning if the owner has not provided the Secretary of the Department of Industry required information in respect of the boat. ***Ocean trawl prawning*** includes the taking of fish using an otter trawl net (prawns) under an offshore prawn endorsement or an inshore prawn endorsement.

Note: if the boat does not require a certificate of survey (exemption 02) under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* or the certificate of survey for the boat issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) does not show the measured length, moulded depth or moulded breadth of the boat determined in accordance with the *National Standard for Commercial Vessels (NSCV)* to two decimal places, you must provide (a) a copy of the AMSA issued certificate of survey for the boat (if one has been issued) AND (b) written confirmation of the measured length, moulded depth or moulded breadth determined in accordance with the NSCV to two decimal places by an accredited marine surveyor or AMSA recognised organisation.

Part E: Fishing Business owner declaration (To be signed by all partners if the fishing business is owned in partnership; the person(s) with authority to sign on behalf of the company if the fishing business is owned by a company)

Section 307B of the *Crimes Act 1900* makes it an offence to provide information to a public authority that you know is false or misleading, or to omit any matter or thing without which the information is misleading. The obligation to provide the required boat information as an ongoing obligation. If a boat is modified, and you have not updated the details held by the Department, you and any endorsement holder using the boat will be in breach of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (clause 10 of the Fisheries Management (Ocean Trawl Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006).
