

VOCABULARY LOOP CARDS



Vocabulary loop cards

Early stage 1 and stage 1

The aim of this set of cards is to improve students' vocabulary about food and fibre. It's a quick activity that you can use to fill in time before the bell while reinforcing garden vocabulary. It can also support struggling readers.

HOW TO PLAY

Distribute the cards with words to students – there are 30 cards if you have fewer students you may choose to leave some out and use them next time if you have fewer students – just remember to take the images out of your pack as well.

Hold up the image cards one at a time, the student with that word on their cards calls out 'I have xyz' and you move on to the next image. Some students will quickly learn to recognise the words. To support other students and to ensure they are reading the word ask students to say the word they have and either spell or say the sounds eg 'I have sheep, sh-ee-p / s-h-e-e-p'.

The cards can also be used to encourage students to use these words on their writing.
